



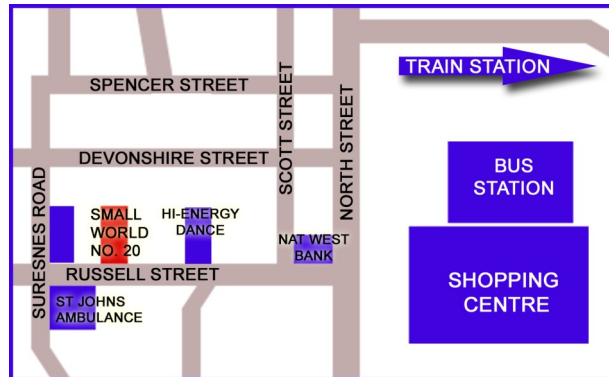

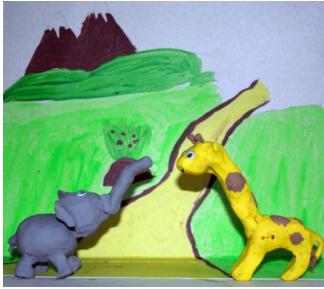

How to find small world



Small World Cultural Arts Collective is running a Creative Writing and Visual Arts projects for young women (11-24 years.) Each group will run over a four to six-month period for two hours every week.



## Who will benefit?

Young women aged 11-25 years who:

Are interested in exploring creative writing & creative arts

Prefer a relaxed learning atmosphere

Are open to trying something new

Are experiencing social exclusion/ feeling a bit lonely or down

Want to create something positive in their lives

Are experiencing difficult personal issues such as depression, low self-esteem, etc.

Have something they want to say



## What can young women get from it?

The opportunity to express feelings and opinions in an original and unique way- eg via documentaries, films, animation, painting or poetry

An understanding of a variety of art and writing techniques

The opportunity to create and maintain a safe, positive & supportive environment

An understanding of the range of choices when 'creating'

The opportunity to make friends

The opportunity to participate in fun and meaningful activity

Support in self expression

The opportunity to choose a project that reflects

their own interests and support in choosing what to do with the art created- e.g. an exhibition, short film, short book etc.

The opportunity to develop confidence

Improved well-being

Arts Award accreditation

Access to information regarding further training

## What is it?

A creative and supportive environment where young women

can explore and develop self-expression, strengths, hopes, feelings, ideas, thoughts and viewpoints through the creative mediums of story writing, autobiographical writing, script-writing, poetry, lyric writing, animation, photo and comic strips, film-making, drawing, puppet making, painting and sculpture

## Aims

To provide a supportive and creative space

To use creative writing and visual arts to develop expression and communication

To raise self-esteem

To develop confidence

To explore new creative techniques

To encourage creativity and 'play'

To encourage young women to develop the projects they have chosen
